- Types of audits and basic steps in the development of an Internal Audit Program
- Phases of an internal audit:
 - ◆ Planning the audit
 - ◆ Conducting the audit
 - ◆ Reporting the audit
 - ◆ Development and resolution of a non-conformity
 - ◆ Audit Follow-up and Verification
- Identification and description of the traits, attributes and characteristics of the 'Qualified Auditor'
- Identification and description of Audit Techniques including effective communication and audit investigations.
